In all interactions, be polite and do not run, resist, or touch agents

## 1) RIGHT TO NOT BE IDENTIFIED WITHOUT CAUSE

On private property (home, the non-public area of a business, etc.) ask for a **warrant signed by a judge**. If ICE does not have one, do not let them enter. If you are stopped do NOT identify yourself or answer any questions. Ask: "Am I being detained?"

- If "No" - say "I do not want to answer questions" and WALK AWAY!
- If "Yes" - move to #2

## 2) RIGHT TO REMAIN SILENT

If you are detained, DO NOT answer any questions, do not disclose status! Say: "I will not answer questions or sign anything until I can **speak with a lawyer**" Say: "I do not consent to a search" if they start looking through your personal property (pockets, bags) Say: "I am afraid to return to my country. I want a fear interview."

### Carry with you:

- Proof of residence in US for 2+ years valid drivers license if driving
- DO NOT CARRY: fake documents
